MYCON General Contractors Completes 14-Screen Cinemark Theatre in McKinney, Texas and Begins Finish-Out of the Cinemark Theatre Auditorium at Dallas Holocaust and Human Rights Museum

Dallas, TX, June 17, 2019 – MYCON announced today that it has completed construction of a new 14-screen Cinemark theatre located at 1701 N. Hardin Blvd. near the intersection of Highway 380 in McKinney, Texas, according to senior vice president of MYCON Justin Jeffus, CDP, LEED AP. Jeffus noted that the new McKinney theatre opened to the public on April 11. Jeffus also added that MYCON is underway on another Cinemark-related project at the Dallas Holocaust and Human Rights Museum in downtown Dallas, Texas.

MYCON acted as the general contractor for the ground-up new construction of Cinemark Theatre's 27th theatre in the Dallas/Fort Worth area. The 53,678 square-foot multiplex theatre includes an XD auditorium, Luxury Lounger seating, a lobby with self-serve concession stands, a Starcade area with a variety of fan-favorite arcade games, restrooms and administrative offices. "Many of our team members and subcontractors live in McKinney so there was that added sense of community pride in delivering this project for Cinemark," says Jeffus. "We especially appreciated that Cinemark included us in their "Friends and Family" event prior to the public opening." The project team included the owner, Cinemark Texas Properties, LLC. and the architect, Beck Architecture.

MYCON is also currently working on the finish-out of a Cinemark theatre auditorium as part of the new Dallas Holocaust and Human Rights Museum located at 300 N. Houston Street in Dallas' historic West End district. The 4,100 square-foot theatre features a 45.6-foot wide screen with enhanced sound system, 250 seats on stadium risers and a lecture stage with AV systems. "We are very pleased to be part of the team building this culturally significant project in the heart of Dallas," says Jeffus. OMNIPLAN Architects of Dallas designed the new building, and Austin Commercial is the general contractor. Interior finish-out of the theatre is scheduled for August 2019.
